

DRESS CODE POLICY FOR FBCS 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR

K5-5th grade

Boys:

1. **Uniform** Khaki or navy flat front or cargo pants or shorts (finger tip rule applies) from the uniform department at the following approved sources: Target, Uniform Depot, Land's End, Kmart, JC Penney, Sears, Gap, Gymboree or Old Navy. **Jeans or jean shorts** (finger tip rule applies) **are not allowed on any day with the exception of Fridays or free dress days.**
2. **Uniform** shirts must be purchased from Uniform Depot. All shirts must have the school logo applied by Uniform Depot. Polo style shirts may be purchased in yellow, green, white or red and can be either long or short sleeved. **A red polo style shirt with the school logo is required for field trips. Logo t-shirts are not acceptable on any day except Fridays.** Shirts must be tucked in.
3. Belts (plain brown, black or navy blue) must be worn when loops are present. Belts may be purchased from any source.
4. Brown or black conservative closed-toed shoes or athletic shoes (from any source). **NO flip-flops, open toed shoes of any type, or any shoes that do not have a rubber sole. NO shoes with wheels. No shoes that have pictures or lights. Also, no sandals or cowboy boots.**
5. Sweaters, sweatshirts and vests (worn inside the building) must be consistent with school colors and have no pictures. Jackets and sweaters (worn outside the building) can be any color.

PE:

1. Solid red t-shirt or sweat shirt (does not need a logo – can be purchased from any source)
2. Navy blue gym shorts or sweat pants (does not need a logo – can be purchased from any source)

Fridays:

On Fridays students are not required to wear uniforms. Students are asked to use modesty and discretion when not wearing a school uniform, including at any event sponsored by FBCS.

Students can wear T-Shirts, fingertip length shorts, skorts, dresses (length should be no more than 2 inches above the knee), capri and cropped pants. **No** Santa Claus, Jack-O-Lantern, Elves, Pokemons, or other "power" figures should be on clothing. No spaghetti straps, backless, or mid-riff shirts.

Girls:

1. **Uniform** khaki or navy skirts/skort. These can be purchased from the uniform department at the following approved sources: Target, Uniform Depot, Land's End, Kmart, JC Penney, Sears, Gap, Gymboree or Old Navy. The plaid jumpers and plaid skirts can still be purchased from Uniform Depot. The jumper must have a logo applied by Uniform Depot. All jumpers, skirts or skorts must be no shorter than 2" above the knee. Privacy shorts are required under all jumpers and skirts.

Uniform khaki or navy flat front pants or shorts (finger tip rule applies) can be purchased from the uniform department at the following approved sources: Target, Uniform Depot, Land's End, Kmart, JC Penney, Sears, Gap, Gymboree or Old Navy. **Jeans or jean shorts are not allowed on any day with the exception of Fridays or free dress days.**

Uniform khaki or navy flat front capri pants from the uniform department at the following approved sources: Target, Uniform Depot, Land's End, Kmart, JC Penney, Sears, Gap, Gymboree or Old Navy.

2. **Uniform** shirts must be purchased from Uniform Depot. All shirts must have the school logo applied by Uniform Depot. Polo style shirts may be purchased in yellow, green, white or red and can be either long or short sleeved. **A red polo style shirt with the school logo is required for field trips. Logo t-shirts are not acceptable on any day except Fridays.** Shirts must be tucked in.
3. Belts (plain brown, black or navy blue) must be worn when loops are present. Belts may be purchased from any source.
4. Navy, red, brown or black conservative closed-toed shoes or athletic shoes (from any source). **NO flip-flops, open toed shoes of any type, or any shoes that do not have a rubber sole. NO shoes with wheels. No shoes that have pictures or lights. Also, no sandals or cowboy boots.**
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
