

FBCS is pleased to announce that we are working with a new catering company for the 2007-2008 school year. The new catering company that will be providing meals for FBCS is A Tasty Touch. It is owned by Vinnie Caracci. Mr. Caracci has been in the restaurant business for 22 years, managing the well known Olive Garden.

After retiring from Olive Garden two years ago, Mr. Caracci started this new catering company. They provide meals for several of the private schools in the Kennesaw area. A Tasty Touch received a restaurant inspection score of 100% for the last two years and has provided required paperwork, proof of a business license and liability insurance to FBCS.

There are many new benefits that students, staff and visitors will experience this year with A Tasty Touch:

1. **More menu choices per day**-Entrée' (some breakfast items for lunch), Sandwich of the day, Salad, or PB&J everyday
2. **Students order on the day they want lunch** – Students will bring home a monthly calendar, but can decide the day of the lunch they choose (by 9:00AM)
3. **Parents/Visitors can order lunches the day of a visit**-(by 9:00AM)
4. **Choices of drinks**-Milk, Juice or Water
5. **Fresh Food**-Meals will be dished out, hot/ cold, on plates AT school (NO MORE TO-GO CONTAINERS!).

With the improvement of the school lunches, there will be an increased lunch charge. The new price per lunch will be \$4.25 per lunch if you pay on a daily basis or \$4.00 per lunch when you purchase a sheet of 5 tickets for \$20.00. The price includes water or milk. Extra milk, juice and water will be available for student to purchase for an additional charge. Checks and money orders are the **ONLY** form of payment that will be accepted if you buy a ticket or buy daily. (exception: students buy extra drinks). **FBCS does not profit from school lunches.**

Enclosed you will find a menu, provided by A Tasty Touch. You will notice a variety of foods. PB&J and a sandwich choice will be offered everyday.

Please read over the menus and give us your feedback. FBCS hopes that you will find this as a positive addition to our school.
